With a generous \$75,000 grant received in 2023, we introduced a dedicated Alzheimer's and Dementia program, significantly enhancing the well-being of our seniors.

Our "Caregiver's Lounge"

expanded in 2023, thanks to a \$75,000 grant, providing vital education and respite for caregivers within our community.



The 2023 end-ofyear holiday bash saw over 200 seniors celebrating together at the

center, enjoying a night filled with joyous entertainment and dancing.

The 2023 holiday season was extra special for 40 caregivers from our Lounge, treated to a festive party with thoughtful gifts for each.

Our Musical Memory Café continued to thrive in 2023, backed by a \$13,000 grant, offering a stage for musicians with dementia to shine.



A \$100,000 grant in 2023 empowered us to offer yearround transportation services, ensuring our seniors have the freedom to travel and engage.

In 2023, a substantial

\$678,095 grant recognized us as Ward Four's Lead Agency, entrusting us with delivering comprehensive senior services.

Our center's operations received a significant boost with a \$386,958 grant in 2023, allowing us to offer a wide array of programs and services.



In partnership with UDC, we

brought Healthy Nutritional workshops to our center, promoting a lifestyle of wellness and vitality among our seniors. Teaming up with the YMCA in 2023, we introduced tailored fitness programs, encouraging our seniors to embrace a more active and healthy lifestyle.

Collaborating with Howard
University in 2023, we introduced Speech and Language Pathology services, focusing on enhancing cognitive health for our seniors.

The "Caregiver's Lounge" was developed in 2023 with a \$51,000 grant, creating a supportive and nurturing environment for those caring for loved ones.

Our "Music Memory Café" was created in 2023 with a \$17,500 grant, offering a unique platform for retired musicians with dementia to perform and connect.
